## Difference between Alpha Testing & Beta Testing | Alpha Testing Vs. Beta Testing

## Difference between Alpha Testing & Beta Testing

	Alpha Testing	Beta Testing
Place	Alpha testing is conducted within the organization.	<b>Beta Testing</b> is conducted at the client's place i.e. outside the organization.
Presence of Developer	In Alpha testing, <b>developer</b> is present there while testing.	In Beta testing, developer is not present while testing as it is tested at client's side
When to Conduct?	When the development of <b>software</b> is near to completion stage, Alpha testing is conducted.	After passing Alpha testing and before the <b>final launching or releasing</b> the software, Beta testing is conducted.
Recording of Errors	In Alpha testing, developer is present while testing so he <b>records</b> all the problems and errors encountered during testing.	In Beta Testing, customer records all the errors and other issues encountered during this testing and <b>reports</b> to the developer.
Who will test?	Alpha testing is conducted within the organization and tested by representative group of end users at the developer's side and sometimes by <b>Independent team of testing.</b>	Beta testing is conducted by the <b>end users</b> or other persons and they are not <b>programmers</b> , <b>software engineers or testers</b> .
Environment	This testing is conducted in virtual & controlledenvironment.	This testing is conducted in real time or live environment.
Public Involvement	This testing is <b>close</b> for public.	This testing is <b>open</b> for public
